a. Resolution #2025-056 - Appointment of Career Firefighter.

On motion of Commissioner Barry, seconded by Commissioner Keyes, the following resolution was adopted: 4 Ayes; 0 Nays

WHEREAS, there exists a vacancy in one of the career firefighter positions with the Victor Fire District;

WHEREAS, an interview committee was formed to review and evaluate candidates for the position of paid firefighter pursuant to the requirements of New York State Civil Service Law and the procedures of Ontario County Civil Service;

WHEREAS, after a thorough interview process, the interview committee recommends the appointment of Alex Juergens to the position of Firefighter/Mechanical with the Victor Fire District; now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED that, based on the recommendation of the interview committee, the Board of Fire Commissioners hereby appoints Alex Juergens to the position of Firefighter/ Mechanical, effective June 30, 2025, on a full-time probationary basis at an annual salary of \$45,760;

RESOLVED that Mr. Juergens may be employed on a part-time basis for training purposes prior to his full-time appointment at an hourly rate based on his annual salary for the hours agreed upon by Mr. Juergens and the Treasurer; and

RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Ontario County Civil Service, and Mr. Juergens.

d. Resolution #2025-059 - Appointment of Volunteer Firefighter Tyler Whitcomb.

On motion of Commissioner Palmer, seconded by Commissioner Keyes, the following resolution was adopted: 3 Ayes; 0 Nays; Abstain (Barry)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Town Law §176, volunteer members of a company shall be appointed by the Board of Fire Commissioners after selection by the fire company;

WHEREAS, Tyler Whitcomb has completed all requirements for membership and been approved by vote of the Victor Fire Department, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners wishes to honor and approve new volunteer firefighters to serve with the Victor Fire Department and to satisfy all legal and insurance requirements for the benefit of our volunteers; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners hereby appoints Tyler Whitcomb to the Victor Fire Department's Hose Company as Firefighter #282 upon a driver's license approval and the passing of a physical examination from Healthworks.

e. Resolution #2025-060 -Authorization for Career Firefighter to Attend Training

WHEREAS, prior to receiving a permanent appointment as a firefighter from an open competitive list, individuals are required to complete a basic fire training program certified by the State Fire Administrator as meeting the requirements of Part 426 and 427, pursuant to General Municipal Law §209-w and Civil Service Law §58-a;

WHEREAS the Victor Fire District Policies require training opportunities where costs or fees are involved must be authorized by the Chief and approved by resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners prior to attendance;

WHEREAS there exists a training opportunity that meet Parts 426 with the Watertown Fire Department Recruit Firefighter Training Program (RFFT) starting August 11, 2025;

WHEREAS the Watertown Fire Department has accepted a request from Chief Lamarco to reserve one seat from Victor Fire District, with the requirements and costs outlined in detail in Appendix A;

WHEREAS the Board of Fire Commissioners have reviewed these requirements and finds that attending the Watertown RFFT is timely, necessary, and in the public interest; therefore, now, be it

RESOLVED the Board of Fire Commissioners authorizes Firefighter Alex Juergens to attend this training;

RESOLVED, that the Board of Fire Commissioners authorizes the use of 2763 for transportation for travel;

RESOLVED, that any necessary expenses will be paid for by the Fire District as is consistent with the Travel Expense and School & Training policies and that the attendees are authorized to use one of the District Credit Cards for expenses on the condition they review the travel policy with the Treasurer prior to departure and with the understanding that any expenses not determined to be consistent with the travel policy shall be refunded to the District within 30 days of notification;

RESOLVED to authorize Chief Lamarco the authority to sign all agreements necessary for this training;

RESOLVED that the expenses for this training will be assigned to A3410.403.13 – Training – Paid FF.

f. Resolution #2025-061 - Authorization for FF 276 to attend advanced training.

WHEREAS, General Municipal Law 72-g and Victor Fire District Policies require training opportunities at the state level must be authorized by the Chief and approved by resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners prior to attendance;

WHEREAS, at the Ontario County Safety Training Facility, OFPC is holding a Fire Service Instructor I course over 5 days, December 5-7 & 14-15;

WHEREAS, Firefighters Tyler Gokey has requested permission to attend this training to further their professional development as a firefighter;

WHEREAS, Chief Lamarco has authorized this training, recognizing there is a benefit to the Victor Fire Department in enhancing operational resources; now, therefore, be it RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners authorizes Firefighter Gokey to attend the Fire Service Instructor I in Ontario County on December 5, 6, 7, 14, & 15 utilizing 2763 (if in service);

RESOLVED, that any necessary expenses will be paid for by the Fire District as is consistent with the Travel Expense and School & Training policies; and

RESOLVED, that the expenses for this training will be assigned to A3410.403.13 Training – Paid FF

g. Resolution #2025-062 - Authorization to Release Bid Specifications.

Correct existing finish texture irregularities to achieve a uniform appearance and texture and remove and replace any damaged sealant/caulk joints, per manufacturer's instructions, in preparation for application of waterproofing and restoration products.
- (5) Prepare and clean entire building per manufacturer's recommendations, prior to application of any waterproofing and restoration products.
- (6) Apply any necessary waterproofing and restoration products to the existing EIFS surface of the building per the manufacturer's instructions. Protect all adjacent surfaces from overspray, splatter, etc.; immediately clean any overspray or splatter from adjacent surfaces not intended to receive coatings.
